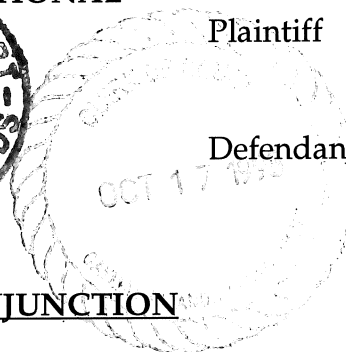

EX PARTE SUMMONS FOR MAREVA INJUNCTION

LET ALL PARTIES concerned attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman, on the day of October, 1995 at a.m./p.m. upon an application by the Plaintiff for orders as follows:-

1. That the Defendant be restrained, whether by herself, her servants or agents or howsoever otherwise, from removing from the jurisdiction, disposing of and/or dealing with her assets within the jurisdiction insofar as the same do not exceed the sum of CI\$6,000, and in particular the bank account or bank accounts at Barclays Bank plc, George Town, Grand Cayman held solely or jointly in her name and/or under her control, or her claims thereto, until judgment herein or further order.

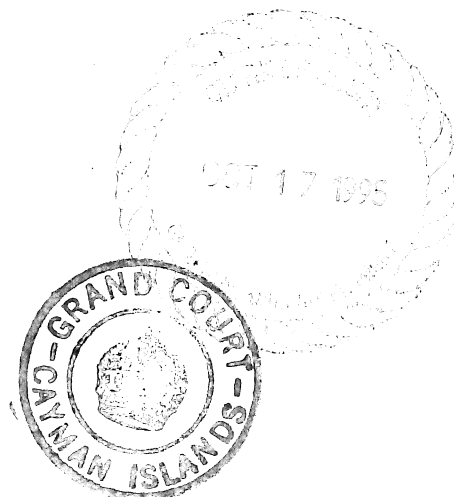
2. (1) That the Defendant be required to inform the Plaintiff in writing at once of all her assets in the Cayman Islands and whether in her own name or not and whether solely or jointly owned, giving the value, location and details of all such assets.

- (2) That the Defendant be further required to confirm this information in an affidavit which must be served on the Plaintiff's attorneys within 21 days after this Order has been served on the Defendant.
- (3) Save that the Defendant shall not be required to provide the Plaintiff with such information if the balance of the said bank account or bank accounts at Barclays Bank plc, George Town, Grand Cayman, is equal to or greater than CI\$6,000.

3. For such further and other relief as may be just.

4. That the costs of this application be reserved.
