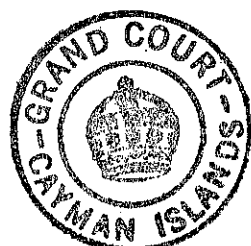

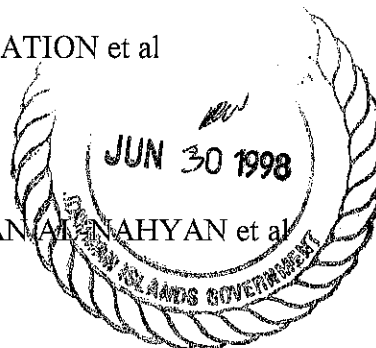

That the said Examiner herein do take down or cause to be taken down in writing the evidence of the said Witnesses in examination, cross-examination and re-examination and further do require the said Witnesses to sign their depositions in the said Examiner's presence and when so completed file them with the Clerk of the Grand Court to be forwarded to the District Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.
4. That the said Witnesses shall make any application which may be necessary under the Confidential Relationships Preservation Law (As Amended).
