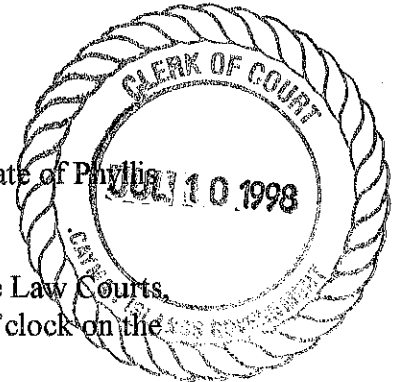

1. That this Honourable Court do sanction and permit the Sale by Private Treaty by the Plaintiff of all that property registered in the Cayman Islands Land Register with absolute title and being particularly know as Registration Section Bodden Town Block 43D, Parcel 94 ("the property") as Chargee with a power of sale over the property.
2. That the Defendant and any other persons occupying the property do, within 28 days of this Order, vacate the property and take all appropriate steps to give the Plaintiff vacant possession of the property.
3. Such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem appropriate.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service to the Court Office.
