PARTICULARS OF CLAIM


(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him)

1. On December 13th, 2021, the Plaintiff approached the Defendant at his place of business on Sound Road to purchase a vehicle, White Truck, Make: Isuzu, Model: NPR, VIN:#JALC4B14X7006973, Year of Manufactory:1999. The vehicle was a used vehicle for the company but was purchased by the Plaintiff that day from the Defendant at a cost of CI\$3,600.00
2. On May 6th 2022, the Defendant electronically signed the Certificate of Vehicle ownership registration to transfer the vehicle to the Plaintiff. While the original form remains unsigned as the Plaintiff had been continually informed that the Defendant is living abroad by a business representative known to the Defendant.
3. Since purchasing the vehicle, from January 19th 2022 onwards the Plaintiff has invested an amount of over CI\$12,775.35 in vehicle parts and labor to have the vehicle up to standard for licensing and registration.
4. After receiving an electronically signed copy of the Certificate of Vehicle Ownership in May 2022, from the Defendant; The Plaintiff took that document to the Department of Vehicle and Licensing to have the vehicle transferred, but was unsuccessful and was told by the officer that a Certificate of Good standing will be required from the Defendant along with the signed original Certificate of Vehicle Ownership Registration to have the vehicle transferred to the Plaintiff.
5. The Plaintiff is requesting that the Defendant signs the original Certificate of Ownership and provide the Plaintiff with the Letter of Good Standing or otherwise provide a reimbursement to the Plaintiff for the cost of the vehicle cost and repairs.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

- 1 The sum of CI\$16,375.35
- 2 Interest in the sum of \$60.27 calculated at the prescribed rate from December 13th 2021 to date.
- 3 Fixed costs of CI\$~~10,000~~^{175.00} alternatively costs to be assessed.
