EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on *10* day of *AUGUST*, 1998 at *9-30 am* on the hearing of an application by Ansbacher (Cayman) Limited of P.O. Box 500, Grand Cayman, B.W.I. who is required by paragraph 2(2) of an Order dated 16 July 1998 ("the Order") to disclose certain information as more particularly described in paragraph 2(2)(a) and 2(2)(b) of the Order and who seeks directions pursuant to Section 4 of the above-mentioned Law.

The Applicant is required by the Order to give in writing confidential information belonging to certain parties to whom the applicant owes a duty of confidentiality and seeks directions that:-

1. The Applicant do disclose to O.S.C. Limited and Petroleum Services Ltd forthwith the information requested in the Order in writing in so far as it affects the First Defendant only.
2. The Applicant do seek a variation of the Order in so far as confidential information is being requested in connection with a person or persons who are not parties to Cause No. 433 of 1998 but to whom the Applicant owes a duty of confidentiality.
3. The disclosure shall be in the form of a letter written to the attorneys at law acting for the Plaintiffs in Cause No. 433 of 1998 or an Affidavit sworn to by an official of the Applicant or in such other form as this Honourable Court shall direct.
4. There shall be no further disclosure without further Order of this Honourable Court.
5. Such further or other directions as this Honourable Court shall deem appropriate.
6. The costs of this Application shall be costs of the Action in Cause No. 433 of 1998.
