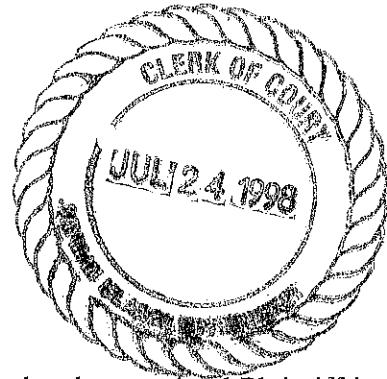

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claims set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledge of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement ~~within the time stated~~, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. In or around 22nd January 1998 the Plaintiff agreed to construct a 2 bedroomed house for the Defendant for the sum of CI\$67,140.00 (sixty-seven thousand, one hundred and forty dollars).
2. The Plaintiff completed the building of the said house in or around June 1998.
3. The Plaintiff received the total sum of CI\$63,740.00 (sixty three thousand, seven hundred and forty dollars) but the Defendant remains indebted to the Plaintiff in respect of the balance of CI\$3,400.00 which sum the Defendant has refused to pay.
4. The Defendant is further indebted to the Plaintiff in the sum of CI\$1,150.00 (one thousand, one hundred and fifty dollars) being the cost of four valuations obtained by the Plaintiff acting as agent for the Defendant in respect of the said building project.

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. Under paragraph 3 above the sum of CI\$3,400.00 (three thousand and four hundred dollars).
2. Under paragraph 4 above the sum of CI\$1,150.00 (one thousand, one hundred and fifty dollars).
3. Interest on the above sums from 29th June 1998 to the date of issue herein of CI\$23.92 (twenty-three dollars and ninety-two cents).
4. Continuing interest pursuant to the Judicature Law until judgment or soon payment of at the daily rate of CI\$1.04 (one dollar and cents).
5. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pay the total amount claimed of CI\$4,923.92 (four thousand, nine hundred and twenty-three CI dollars and ninety-two cents) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.
