


PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. Between 2017 to present the defendant, with consent of the Plaintiff, used the Plaintiff's car, Audi TT, as a loan with the value of Five Thousand Five Hundred Cayman Islands Dollars (CI\$5,500).
