I, CRYSTAL THERESE HENNINGS, of 120 Westbury Leigh, Westbury, Wiltshire, BA13 3SH; England, formerly of West Bay, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, being the youngest daughter and Executor-referred to as Crystal Hennings-Wilkins in the Last Will and Testament of the late BASIL LINMON HENNINGS, formerly of 166 Walker's Road, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, surviving the deceased, being over the age of eighteen years and not having renounced Probate, which said Will was made at Cayman Brac, Cayman Islands on the 8th day of August 2012 and the said Will, at the time of the death of the deceased having been found lying at the residence of the late BASIL LINMON HENNINGS situated at 166 Walker's Road, George Town, Grand Cayman and in his custody, which said Will, together with the certificate of death, is annexed hereto, hereby apply for a Grant of Probate of the said Last Will and Testament and I enclose herewith my Affidavit in that behalf and I undertake that in the event of such grant being made to me, that I will:

- a) within six months of the grant to me of Probate of the said Last Will and Testament I will prepare a true Inventory of the said Estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- b) within one year of such grant to me, I will administer the estate according to the tenor of the Last Will and Testament and the directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general account accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
