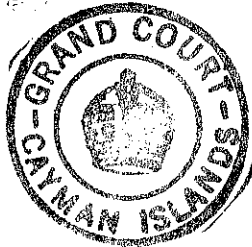

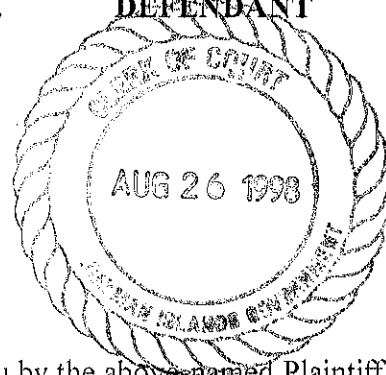

WRIT OF SUMMONS

**THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS** has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

**Within** fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 26th day of August, 1998.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.



### SPECIAL INDORSEMENT

1. The plaintiff is a local company licensed to sell ready mixed concrete.
2. The defendant is a builder.
3. On the 24th October, 1997 the defendant obtained 50 yards of concrete from the plaintiff and gave it a cheque for \$5,875.00 drawn on Cayman National Bank as payment.
4. Upon presentation of the cheque to the Bank it was discovered that the defendant did not have enough money to cover the cheque and it was returned to the plaintiff.
5. The plaintiff notified the defendant and demanded immediate payment in full.
6. On the 21st November, 1997 the defendant paid the plaintiff \$1,000.00 and promised to pay the balance of \$4,875.00 but to date he has failed to pay.

Wherefore the plaintiff claims:-

1. The balance of \$4,875.00 with interest at the rate of 7 7/8 % per annum from the 24th October, 1997 until payment and costs to be taxed or agreed.

## **Notes on address for service**

**Attorney:** Where the defendant is represented by an Attorney, state the Attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A defendant may not act by a foreign Attorney.

**Defendant in person:** Where the defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered or principal office.
