EX PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS

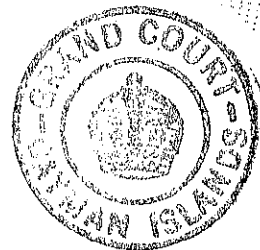
LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the ^{3rd} day of ~~November~~ 1995 at 9.30 o'clock in the fore noon, on the hearing of an Application by the Honourable Attorney-General for orders that:

1. Mark Whitacre and/or Sidney Hulse and/or ABP Trading Ltd and/or ABP Consulting Ltd (hereinafter called "the Defendants") whether by themselves individually or by their agents, directors, servants, officers or otherwise howsoever until further order, be restrained from transferring, assigning withdrawing, removing from the jurisdiction, or otherwise disposing of or dealing with any funds currently deposited to any account in Grand Cayman at Swiss Bank and Trust Corporation Ltd and/or Morgan Grenfell Ltd., and/or Caledonian Bank and Trust Ltd., in the name(s) of or for the benefit of any or all of the Defendants;
2. That the Defendants be restrained in particular whether by themselves individually or by their agents, directors, servants, officers or otherwise howsoever from withdrawing, removing from the jurisdiction, assigning, transferring or otherwise disposing of or dealing with any funds deposited to account numbers 41327 and 53413 at Swiss Bank and Trust Corporation Ltd, Grand Cayman;
3. That the Court file in relation to this matter be deemed a closed file to be kept in a safe place in the office of the Clerk of the Courts until further order; and
4. Such further orders or directions as this Honourable Court shall deem fit.
