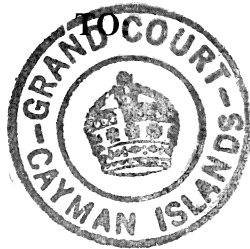

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 2nd day of September 1998.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months, (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiffs are a firm of Attorneys who at all material times were retained by the Defendant as her Attorneys and who carried out work at the Defendant's request and on her behalf in relation to matrimonial proceedings, the brief reference to the record whereof is Grand Court Cause No. D2 of 1995, and therein expended money on her behalf.

Particulars

4th January 1995 to 3rd June 1996, Professional charges and disbursements for work carried out on behalf of and at the request of the Defendant, as her Attorneys, and more particularly set out in the Bill of Costs dated 3rd June 1996 and delivered to the Defendant on 4th June 1996.

2. The Plaintiffs' Bill of Costs dated 3rd June 1996 claimed a total amount of CI\$53,416.33. The Defendant made two payments of CI\$1,000 each in June and July 1996, leaving a balance of CI\$51,416.33 due and owing from the Defendant to the Plaintiffs.


3. Although requested to so, the Defendant has not paid to the Plaintiffs the outstanding balance of money or fees or any part thereof.

4. The Plaintiffs are entitled to and hereby claim interest pursuant to Section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) on the sum of CI\$51,416.33 at the rate of 7.875 % per annum, being CI\$11.093 *per diem*, from the date of issue hereof until judgment herein or sooner payment.

AND the Plaintiffs CLAIM: -

1. Under paragraph 2 hereof, the sum of CI\$51,416.33;
2. Under paragraph 4 hereof, interest on the sum of CI\$51,416.33 at the rate of 7.875 % per annum, being CI\$11.093 *per diem*, from the date of issue hereof until judgment herein or sooner payment;
3. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount of CI\$52,445.49 being the principal sum claimed of CI\$51,416.33, plus fixed costs of CI\$500 and filing fees of CI\$529.16, further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiffs.
