**ORDER**

---

**UPON** the application of Jason Robinson and Jeffrey Stower in their capacity as Joint Official Liquidators (*JOLs*) of Vantage Drilling Company (in Official Liquidation) (the *Company*) dated 15 March 2023

**AND UPON** reading the Second Affidavit of Mr Jeffrey Stower dated 5 April 2023 and Exhibit JS-2 thereto

**AND UPON** considering the application to be suitable to be disposed of on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

- 1 The remuneration of the JOLs for the period 1 October 2020 to 30 April 2022 in the amount of US\$215,899 (comprising fees of US\$212,199 and expenses of US\$3,700) is approved.
- 2 The remuneration of the JOLs for the period 1 May 2022 to the date of dissolution of the Company in the fixed amount of US\$109,863 is approved.
- 3 The Company be dissolved, such dissolution to take effect 14 days from the date of this Order.
- 4 The requirement to publish notice of the dissolution hearing pursuant to CWR O.22, r.1 (3) be dispensed with.

- 5 The JOLs' liquidation file be retained by the JOLs for a period of at least seven years.
- 6 The books and records of the Company (**Documents**) be retained by the JOLs for a period of at least three months following the date of dissolution of the Company.
- 7 The Documents may be destroyed on or after the date falling three months after the Company is dissolved.
- 8 Jason Robinson and Jeffrey Stower be discharged as JOLs.
- 9 The costs of and occasioned by this application be paid as an expense of the liquidation.
