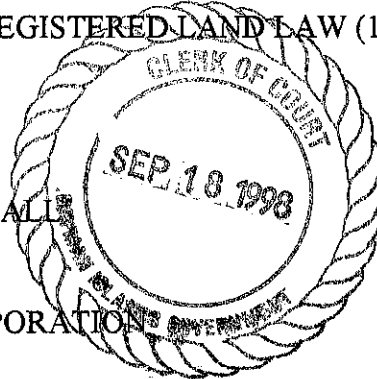

LET THE DEFENDANTS, within fourteen (14) days after service of this Summons on them, counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office, P.O. Box 495 G, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, B.W.I.

By this Summons, which is issued on the application of Eveleen Gail Randall, of P.O. Box 2095 GT, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, B.W.I., the Plaintiff claims against the Defendants:

1. A DECLARATION that the first defendant has not advanced money on a current account to the plaintiff.
2. AN ORDER that the cautions entered in the registers of the lands described as Registration Section West Bay Beach South, Block 12C, Parcels 162 and 163 upon the application of the first defendant on 13th June, 1989 be removed.
3. FURTHER and/or other relief.
4. AN ORDER that the first defendant pay the plaintiff's costs of this action.

If the Defendants do not acknowledge service, such judgment may be given or order made against or in relation to them as the Court may think just and expedient.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF SERVICE OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS

The accompanying form of Acknowledgment of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. The Defendant is required to complete an Acknowledgment of Service and return it to the Court's Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner), you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the acknowledgment of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, an originating summons served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY, the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.
8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.
9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Court's Office.

Notes on address for service


Attorney: where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

Defendant in person: where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
