


AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS :-

1. A declaration that the grant of easement referred to in the Incumbrances Section as entry number 1 in the Land Register relating to Registration Section South Sound Block 7C Parcel 103 is void ab initio and of no effect.
2. In the alternative, a declaration that the Defendant is not entitled to any right of way over and in respect of Registration Section South Sound Block 7C Parcel 103 or any part thereof.
3. Further and in the alternative a declaration that the Defendant is not entitled to any right of way over or in respect of Registration Section South Sound Block 7C Parcel 103 or any part thereof for the benefit of the Defendants land being Registration Section South Sound Block 7C Parcel 86.
4. An injunction restraining the occupiers of Registration Section South Sound Block 7C Parcel 86 and/or the Defendants employees or agents or otherwise howsoever whether on foot or in or upon any vehicle or otherwise from doing the following things or any of them, and from licensing or inviting any visitor to or onto the Defendants land:-
 - i) Going onto the Plaintiff's property or any part thereof
 - ii) Further and in the alternative to i), using or passing over the Plaintiff's property or any part thereof for the purpose of obtaining access to or egress from the Defendant's land or any part thereof.
5. An order that the Land Register relating to Registration Section South Sound Block 7C Parcel 103 be rectified by deleting entry number 1 therein relating to the said grant of easement.
6. Damages.
7. Interest on all sums awarded as damages in accordance with section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision).
8. Further and/or other relief.
9. Costs.
