NOTICE OF MOTION

TAKE NOTICE that Mr. Justice sitting at the Law Courts, George Town, on the 29th day of Oct 1998 at o'clock in the forenoon or so soon thereafter as Counsel can be heard on behalf of the Plaintiffs will be moved by Counsel for the Plaintiffs for an Order [pursuant to Part I of the GCR Order 52] that each of the Defendants be committed to prison on the grounds that each of the Defendants is in breach of the Order made by this Court on the 1 day of December 1997 whereby it was adjudged, *inter alia*, that :

1. The Defendants, their servants, agents or assigns which term includes all occupants and residents at the time being on the property known as West Bay North West Block 1C Parcel 23 be restrained from molesting, using and/or threatening to use violence against the Plaintiffs and from interfering in any way with the Plaintiffs quiet enjoyment of the land known as Registration Section West Bay North West Block 1C Parcels 13, 187, 204, 205, 206, 207, 22 REM 1, 26 and 28 which expression shall include but not be limited to not trespassing or defecating upon the Plaintiffs land, not parking vehicles on the Plaintiffs land, not blocking the access to the Plaintiffs land, not littering the Plaintiffs land or throwing garbage on it and not molesting or harassing the Plaintiffs guests.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the grounds of this application are that the Defendants are in breach of each and all of the Orders mentioned above.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the Applicant intends to rely upon the Affidavit of Thomas J. Thurner sworn to on the 21st day of September 1998 a copy of which is served herewith.
