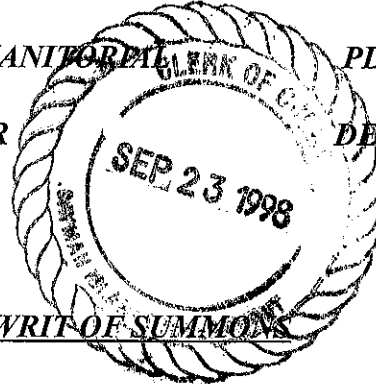

**THIS SPECIALLY ENDORSED WRIT OF SUMMONS** has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within [14 days] after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service, stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

***If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.***

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**


1. The Plaintiff was at all material times between the 27<sup>th</sup> June 1998 and the 24<sup>th</sup> July 1998 contracted by the Defendant to carry out cleaning, maintenance and renovation works at the Defendant's residence.
2. Pursuant to that agreement, the Plaintiff provided the necessary services including the cleaning and painting of walls, removal of garbage and other refuse, pruning of trees, construction of a wall, the spreading of topsoil and the hiring of a crane for the removal of a tree as per the Defendant's instructions.
3. On the 31<sup>st</sup> July 1998 the Plaintiff produced a detailed invoice of the cost of the aforementioned services to the Defendant who despite demands both orally and in writing by the Plaintiff has not paid the debt.

***AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS:***

1. The sum of CI\$5042.00 being the cost of the services provided to the Defendant by the Plaintiff.
2. The sum of CI\$300.00 being the cost of the hiring of a crane by the Plaintiff as instructed by the Defendant.
3. Interest at the Statutory rate from the 31<sup>st</sup> July 1998 to settlement of Judgment.
4. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of \$6417.00 (including interest and cost) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney.
