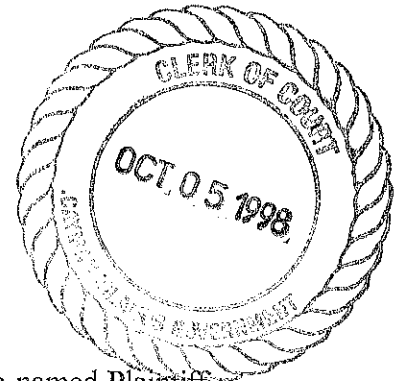

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

SPECIAL INDORSEMENT

1. The plaintiff is a local company and operates a business called "A. L. Thompson's Home Depot"
2. The defendants are husband and wife and live in North Side.
3. On or about the 26th November, 1996 the defendants opened a credit account at the plaintiff's business to get material on credit to build a house on their property, Parcel 47 Block 4D George Town South. They promised that upon completion of the house they would obtain a loan from the bank and pay off the debt.
4. As a result the plaintiff gave the defendant credit to the tune of \$19,961.34 which despite the fact that the house has been completed over an year ago and despite several demands the defendants have failed to pay the debt due.
