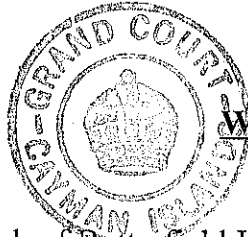

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

THE PLAINTIFF'S CLAIM is for: -

1. An order that the Second Defendant pay to the First Defendant damages for breaches of contract and/or negligence on the part of the Second Defendant in relation to advice provided by the Second Defendant from 1992 onwards to the First Defendant as trustee of the trusts of a settlement dated the 13th day of September 1989 made between Tony Djeddah and the First Defendant, then known as The Bank of N. T. Butterfield & Son (Cayman) Limited, as a result of which breaches of contract and/or negligence trust assets were misapplied by the Second Defendant whereby the Plaintiff has suffered loss and damage;
2. interest pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision); and
3. costs.

The Plaintiff sues in her capacity as a beneficiary of the said trust.

The First Defendant is joined as trustee of the said trust.
