PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. On the 9th of March 2023 the Plaintiff was involved in a motor vehicle accident on the roundabout of 182 Reverend Blackman Rd, West Bay, Grand Cayman cause by the Defendant.
2. The Defendant was quick to acknowledge he was wrong and offer is drivers license when he was ask by the Plaintiff, the Defendant then told the Plaintiff he didn't have any insurance but he will take care of the damages he insist of leaving before the police could arrive on the seen.
3. On the 15th of March 2023 the Plaintiff gave the Defendant two (2) estimates from Andy Auto Ltd. and Island Style Auto Works outlining the cost of the vehicle repairs via WhatsApp. The Defendant request two (2) new estimates from repair shops of his choice, Vampt Motors Ltd. and H&R Auto Body Shop; The Defendant agreed to pay the \$25 for the estimate charge that's was required by H&R Auto Body Shop.
4. The Defendant received the new estimate as he requested on the 23rd of March 2023. The Defendant agreed to move forward with the estimate from Island Style Auto Works \$2,050.00. The Defendant agreed to pay 50% deposit of the estimate on the 24th of March 2023, and the remaining 50% when the job is complete with the additional \$25 CI.
5. All other avenues and legal methods was used to obtain payment. The Defendant refused to pay and insist the Plaintiff should use the court system as the resolve.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

- (1) The sum of \$2,075 CI for the motor vehicle repairs and estimate.
- (2) Lost wages \$566 CI.
- (3) Damages.
- (4) Interest calculated at the prescribed rate from 29/9/23 to date.
- (5) If the Defendant intends to contest these action \$176.72 CI to be calculated per day for each day taking off work due to court appointment until this matter is settled at the calculated day rate for there Plaintiff.
- (6) Fixed costs of \$175 alternatively costs to be assessed.
