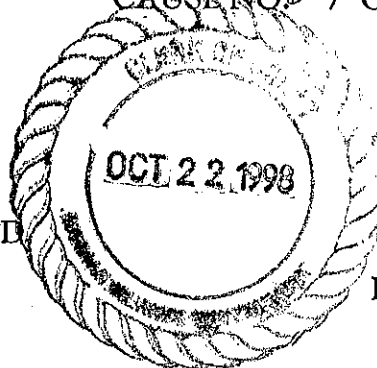
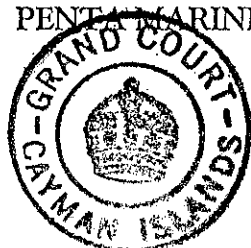

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT of the Tower Building, George Town, Grand Cayman attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the day of NOV 1998, at 2:15 o'clock on the hearing of an application by PENTA MARINE (CAYMAN) LTD. ("Penta") for an Order: 12/12

1. That the Defendant restore Penta to the Register of Companies on payment of reinstatement and other fees due and thereupon Penta shall be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off the Register of Companies.
2. Such further or other relief as the Court deems just.

3. That the Defendant advertise the restoration in the Cayman Islands Gazette upon service on him of a duly sealed copy of the Order granted.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within 14 days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office.
