

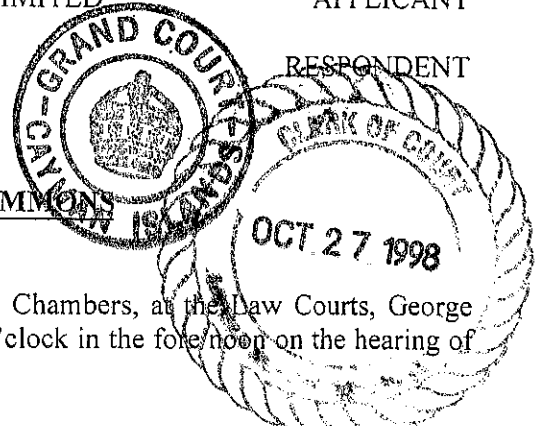

EX-PARTE ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers, at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 28th day of October, 1998 at 9.30 o'clock in the forenoon on the hearing of an application by the Applicant for the following Orders:-

1. That the Respondent does provide to the Applicant or its Attorneys or duly authorised agents true, complete and unredacted copies of all documents or records (including documents and records that are stored electronically by means of computer or on computer hardware or other disk or otherwise) in its possession, custody or power relating to:
 - (a) any account or accounts in the name of Sales Promotion International Limited ("SPIL"), a company that was incorporated in the Cayman Islands, and Doreen Gray (otherwise known as Doreen Mutschmann) ("Gray") into which monies have been transferred whether directly or indirectly from the following accounts:-
 - (i) any account in the name of the Applicant but, more specifically, any account in the name of the Applicant held at National Westminster Bank, Penzance, Cornwall, United Kingdom, Branch, Sort Code 60-16-22, with account numbers 82895678, 99041049 and 05706149.
 - (ii) any account, whether the same be held solely or jointly or held by nominees or agents or trustees or otherwise in respect of all those persons and corporations listed in Schedule 1 to this Summons.
 - (b) the following transfers or payments or any of them ("the payments") that is to say:-
 - (i) the payment of Stg.£168,132.25 from the Applicant to SPIL by way of cheque numbered 736848 on 22nd February 1990;
 - (ii) the payment of Stg.£400,000.00 from Quadrant Tube Company Ltd. on or about March 1990;
 - (iii) the transfer or payment approximately Stg.£188,693.00 by Specialist Anodising Company Ltd. ("SACO") on or about 1st March 1990;
 - (iv) the payment of Stg.£101,009.00 by Topaz Hair Cosmetics Ltd. ("Topaz") on or about November 1990;

- (c) The destination of any monies paid out of any of the accounts identified in paragraphs (a) and (b) above (the "Accounts");
 - (d) The opening of the Accounts and the operation thereof;
 - (e) All dealings with or in the Accounts from the dates upon which they were opened onwards, including:
 - (i) all statements of account relating to the Accounts;
 - (ii) all correspondence relating to the Accounts between any parties;
 - (iii) all internal memoranda relating to the Accounts;
 - (iv) all documents containing information or instructions concerning the Accounts and payments and transfers relating thereto;
 - (v) all cheques drawn on the Accounts and all debit vouchers, transfer applications, transfer instructions and transfer orders relating to the Accounts;
 - (f) All correspondence between or involving the persons or entities referred to in Schedule 1 or any of them to any person or entity authorised to give or who has at any time given or is given instructions relating to the Accounts or any person or entity whose name is referred to in any of the documents or records referred to in this paragraph of this Order or who has signed such documents.
2. That the Respondent be restrained until further Order of this Court from doing (whether by their officers, servants, agents or otherwise) without the written consent of the Plaintiff the following acts or any of them that is to say parting with possession of or destroying or mutilating or amending or deleting or removing or disposing of any of the documents or records referred to in paragraph 2 above.
3. The Respondent be restrained until further Order of this Court from doing (whether by their officers, servants, agents or otherwise) without the written consent of the Plaintiff the following acts or any of them that is to say:-
- (a) Disclosing to any third party the fact that this Application has been made or the result of it or the content of this Order;
 - (b) Producing to any third party or otherwise disclosing any information provided to the Court in connection with this Application including but not limited to any of the contents of any documents filed with the Court in the course of or in connection with these proceedings;
 - (c) Communicating the fact of compliance with the terms of this Order with any of the entities named above or any other third party;
 - (d) Identifying to any person other than the Applicants, its attorneys or duly appointed agents the documents to be disclosed to the Applicant in compliance with this Order, save for the purpose of the Respondent Bank obtaining legal advice or of complying with this Order;

- (e) From warning any third party that the Applicant might make a claim or commence any proceedings against any parties;


Save for the purpose of the Respondent bank obtaining legal advice or of complying with this Order.

4. The Court file on this matter shall not be opened to inspection without leave of the Court.
5. Directions to be given as to any application which may be necessary under Section 4 of the Confidential Relationships (Preservation) Law, Schedule 1.
