PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. Negligence of the George Town Police (RCIPS) has provoked Mr. Keith and Marlene Barnes of Randyke Garden Apartment #26 George Town Cayman Islands, to harass Ms. Lovell Marriott with threatening violence and violence that led to damage to Ms. Lovell Marriott's Property at Randyke Garden Apartment #25 George Town Cayman Islands. Ms. Made 25 reports to the Police and gave 4 Statements to the Commissioner of Police Office yet nothing was done to resolve the matter.


2. Ms. Marriott received a hit to her head by Marlene Barnes and was hospitalized. Rocks were thrown in the windows, and doors of Ms. Lovell Marriott's home. Her 4-car tires were slashed with damage to the roof, backlight, and scratches to the side and front, Keith and Marlene Barnes destroyed Ms. Marriott's boat and disposed of it. Items that were left on Keith Barnes's property by his permission were placed in the rain and then dumped are 8 Oversized Mohangany Doors a 32" Stainless steel Refridgerator a 32" stainless steel glass top Stove, 15 office desk, and other items for her business.

3. All of the above was video recorded while the act took place and sent to the Commissioner of Police headquarters office. Since October 18, 2023, Ms. Lovell Marriott's home has been left with damaged windows that caused an infestation of roaches, and life-threatening fumes from the Generator running throughout the day and night on Keith Barnes's front porch.
