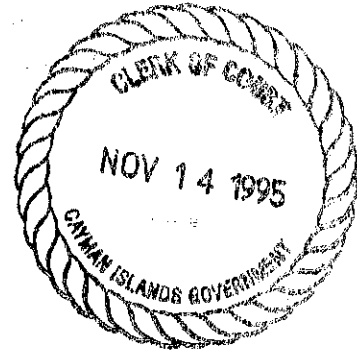
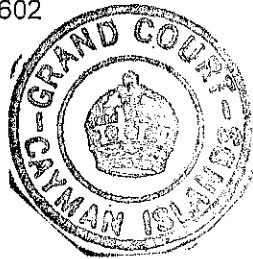

If you fail to satisfy the claim or return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may entered against you forthwith without further notice.

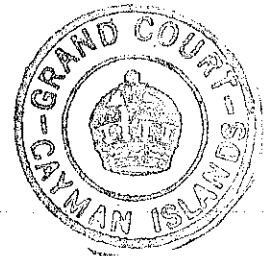

INDORSEMENT OF CLAIM

In August 1994, The First Defendant stole US\$1.2 million from the Plaintiff and credited same to the Second Defendant's account with Guardian Bank and Trust, George Town, Grand Cayman. The First Defendant then transferred US\$400,000 to his account with the Third Defendant. The Plaintiff claims US\$400,000 damages from the First and Second Defendants and/or similar reimbursement from the Third Defendant, and interest at 8%% from 15 August 1994, and costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pay the total amount claimed of US\$444,351.98 (including costs and interest) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff's Attorney.
