

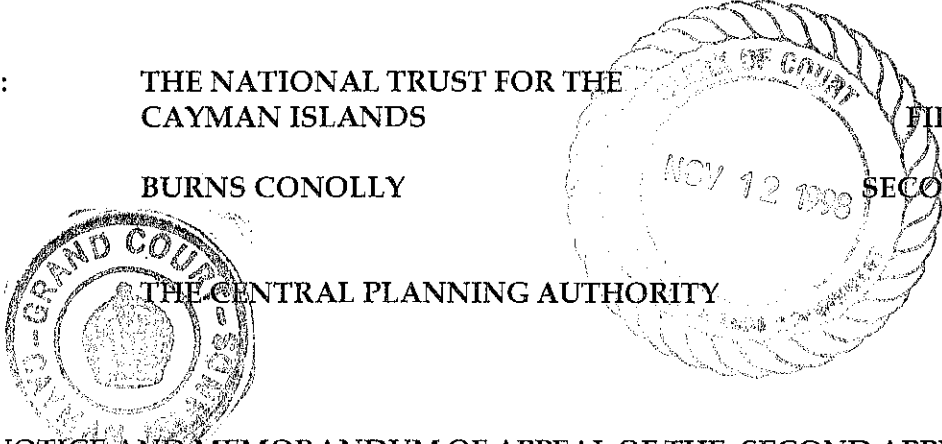

NOTICE OF APPEAL

TAKE NOTICE that the Grand Court will be moved so soon as counsel can be heard on behalf of the Second Appellant on appeal from the decision of the Appeals Tribunal dated 13<sup>th</sup> October 1998 and served on the Second Appellant on 30<sup>th</sup> October 1998 that the Second Appellant was not a "person aggrieved" within the meaning of section 45 of the Development and Planning Law (1998 Revision).


MEMORANDUM OF APPEAL

TAKE NOTICE that the ground of appeal upon which the Second Appellant intends to rely is that the Appeals Tribunal erred in law in finding that the Second Appellant was not a "person aggrieved" within the meaning of section 45 of the Development and Planning Law (1998 Revision) whereas in fact the Second Appellant was a "person aggrieved" within the meaning of that section.

**AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE** that the Second Appellant seeks an order:

1. That the said decision of the Appeals Tribunal be quashed;
2. That the costs of and incidental to this appeal may be paid by the Central Planning Authority and by any other party appearing herein to oppose the appeal.
