THIS PLAINT has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within 14 days after service of this Plaint on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy this claim or return to the Court Office, PO Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service form stating therein whether you intend to contest this action. If you intend to defend the action, in whole or in part, you must set out **full particulars of your defence** in the space provided in the Acknowledgment of Service form.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or fail to return the Acknowledgment of Service form containing full particulars of your defence the Plaintiff may apply for a **default judgment** without any further notice to you.

PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a firm of attorneys formed as a general partnership under the laws of Hong Kong and registered with and regulated by the Law Society of Hong Kong.
2. The registered office of the Plaintiff is 11/F and Suite 1602, Central Tower, 28 Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong.
3. The Defendant is an exempted limited company incorporated in the Cayman Islands and listed on the NASDAQ stock exchange. It carries on business in the renewable energy sector.
4. The Defendant's registered office address is Cricket Square, Hutchins Drive, P.O. Box 2681, Grand Cayman, KY1-1111, Cayman Islands. It maintains a place of business at Room 4B, 2/F., Wah Chun Industrial Centre, 95 Chai Wan Kok Street, Tsuen Wan, New Territories, Hong Kong.
5. By an email dated 5 May 2022 ("**Fee Quote**") from the Plaintiff to the Defendant, the Plaintiff quoted a fee of US\$3,800.00 to advise the Defendant in relation to proposed amendments to the Defendant's articles of association to achieve compliance with Appendix III to the Hong Kong Listing Rules.
6. By an email dated 12 May 2022, the Defendant accepted the Plaintiff's Fee Quote.
7. Between May 2022 and July 2022, the Plaintiff duly advised the Defendant in accordance with the Fee Quote, culminating in the Plaintiff issuing a Confirmation Letter dated 29 July 2022 in which the Plaintiff confirmed that the Defendant's amended memorandum and articles of association were in compliance with Cayman Islands law.
8. On 21 November 2022, the Plaintiff issued invoice #6005641 in the sum of US\$3,800.00 (the "**Invoice**").
9. In breach of the Defendant's obligation to pay the Invoice within a reasonable time, the Defendant has failed to pay the Invoice.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

1. An order that the Defendant do pay to the Plaintiff the sum of US\$3,800.00.
2. Interest pursuant to section 34 of the Judicature Act (2021 Revision).
3. Fixed costs of CI\$150 plus CI\$25 for the filing fee pursuant to SCR 11(1).
4. Alternatively, costs to be assessed by the Magistrate under SCR 11(3).
