STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The plaintiff is a business-man who operates a paint and body shop in the name, Automobile Paint and Body Shop.
2. The defendant lives at Silver Oak, Apartment No. 15 off Crewe Road, Grand Cayman and is the owner of a Mercedes Motor Car Registration No. 52325.
3. On or about the 28th July, 1998 the defendant brought his motor car to the plaintiff's body shop to be repaired and promised to pay the sum of \$2,000.00, the amount charged for the job.
4. On or about the 5th August, 1998 the job was completed. The defendant took the car and promised to return the following day and pay the \$2,000.00.
5. The following day the defendant returned with the car and told the plaintiff that there was a spot on the car which needed attention. The plaintiff told the defendant to bring the car the following day and he would have it rectified and collect his money.

6. However, the defendant failed to return the following day and about two weeks later, the plaintiff saw the defendant and asked him why he had not returned with the car to be rectified. The defendant replied that his wife had to use the car to go to work and he could not afford to bring it back.
7. The plaintiff told the defendant to bring the car the following day and he would give him a rent a car at the plaintiff's own expense until the spot was fixed. He could then return the rent a car, pay him the \$2,000.00 and collect his car.
8. Despite the offer the defendant did not take the car back to the plaintiff neither has he paid the plaintiff his \$2,000.00.

WHEREFORE the plaintiff claims:-

- i. The amount due for the repairs =\$2,000.00
- ii. Interest at the rate of 7 7/8 % per annum from the 5th day of August, 1998 until payment; and
- iii. Costs to be taxed or agreed.
