PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him)

1. On February 6th 2024, Plaintiff hired the services of L & M Carpentry to assist her with the installation of kitchen cabinets and Laminate to be installed at 214 Palm Dale. She made a deposit of \$2,937.50CI via account transfer to a third-party Amanda Stewart (defendant's daughter) bank account.
2. The Plaintiff made a deposit without signing a contract; with understanding that she could inform the defendant with details of the cabinets and countertop she wanted later on.
3. Defendant offered to give Plaintiff a discount on purchase if she made a deposit securing material that she had in stock. Total discount \$625.00. On February 15th/16th 2024 a dispute occurred.
4. On February 21st 2024 a police report was made against the defendant. #2024-005382. A promise was made to refund in full on March 18th 2024. No payment received to date. The Defendant should now also pay interest at the prescribed rate on the cost of the said deposit as at the date of this AND the Plaintiff claims:
Plaint as well as at the per diem rate until the cost of the said deposit has been repaid.

1 The sum of \$2,937.50 CI

2 Interest in the sum of \$8.17 calculated at the prescribed rate from 18th March 2024 to date.

3 Fixed costs of \$175.00, alternatively costs to be assessed.
