ORDER

UPON the Summons dated 19 March 2024 of Roy Bailey, Richard Zhang, and Keiran Hutchison, the Joint Official Liquidators (the “JOLs”) of YINGLI GREEN ENERGY HOLDING COMPANY LIMITED (IN OFFICIAL LIQUIDATION) (the “**Company**”), for an order for the dissolution of the Company and directions

AND UPON reading the Second Affidavit of Roy Bailey sworn 18 March 2024 and the First Affidavit of Keiran Hutchison sworn on 30 April 2024, and the exhibits thereto

AND UPON reading the Second Report of the Joint Official Liquidators to the Creditors of the Company (the “**JOLs’ Second Report**”) dated 22 February 2024

AND UPON reading the Final Report of the Joint Official Liquidators of the Company dated 20 April 2024 (the “**JOLs’ Final Report**”)

AND UPON reading the Skeleton Argument of the JOLs dated 1 May 2024

AND UPON directing that the application may be dealt with administratively on the papers without the need for an oral hearing

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Company be dissolved forthwith.

2. The JOLs be discharged from office and released from any further duties and liability forthwith.
3. The JOLs' liquidation files be preserved for a period of three years after the date of the dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs shall be at liberty to destroy such liquidation files.
4. The Company's books and records shall be preserved by the JOLs for at least three years after the date of dissolution of the Company, after which time the JOLs shall be at liberty to destroy such books and records.
5. The requirement to advertise the hearing of the dissolution application be dispensed with.
6. This Order shall be filed with the Registrar of Companies within 14 days from the date upon which the order is perfected.
7. The costs of and incidental to this summons be paid out of the assets of the Company as an expense of the liquidation.
