Within 14 days after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued this 7th day of December 1998.

NOTE – This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (*or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months*) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.



1. An injunction restraining the Defendant from doing, whether by themselves their employees or agents or any of them or otherwise howsoever the following acts or any of them that is to say printing and or publishing in the "Caymanian Compass" newspaper or any other publication published by the Defendants or otherwise, either the whole or other part or parts of that certain licence made between the Government of the Cayman Islands of the one part and Cable and Wireless (West Indies) limited of the other part and dated the 13th day of December 1991 or any of the information contained therein.
2. An Order that the defendant its employees and/or agents do deliver up to the plaintiff all copies of the aforesaid licence, whether in document or machine readable form, or otherwise howsoever in their possession or under their control.
3. All such further enquires, orders, declarations, relief and directions as may to the Court seem just and appropriate.
