PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him)

1. On September 29th, 2023, the Plaintiff purchased a Jeep Wrangler and took it to a mechanic because needed repairs to pass the inspection. The Jeep was bought for CI\$2,500 on the same day.
2. The mechanic, Wayne Bodden, agreed to repair the Jeep within two weeks for the amount of CI \$2,500. CI\$1200 was transferred on September 29th 2023 to the account provided by the Defendant, and \$1400 was transferred on October 17th, 2023 to cover the repairs and purchase new tires.
3. After more than 7 months, the Defendant has not repaired the Jeep or refunded the Plaintiff's money, nor returned the Jeep. Additionally, the Defendant now claims that the Jeep has stopped working. It should be noted that the Jeep was running when purchased.
4. The Defendant should reimburse the Plaintiff the money paid for the job repairs that were not done plus \$2500 for damages and to get the Jeep fixed. In addition, the Jeep should be returned to the Plaintiff.
5. The Defendant should also pay interest at the prescribed rate on the cost of the Jeep as at the date of this Plaintiff.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

- 1 The sum of CI\$ 5,100.
- 2 Interest in the sum of \$ 61.24 calculated at the prescribed rate from 17/10/2023 to date.
- 3 Fixed costs of \$ 150, alternatively costs to be assessed.
