PARTICULARS OF CLAIM

(Here set out in numbered paragraphs the grounds upon which the Plaintiff claims that the Defendant is indebted to him or is liable to pay damages to him)

- 1 On January 31, 2024, the Defendant borrowed \$1,300.00 and agreed to pay back the full amount plus 20% of the amount borrowed by Feb 27, 2023, of a total of \$1,560.00 (Exhibit 1)
- 2 A contract was signed between the Plaintiff and the defendant fully explaining the terms and conditions including the late fees and legal action. to which the defendant stated that he fully understood.
- 3 On March 1, 2023, the plaintiff called the defendant and learned that the phone was disconnected.
- 4 On October 31, 2023, the plaintiff sent an email requesting payment and warning the defendant that legal action, the defendant replied stating various reasons why he did not pay (Exhibit 2)
- 5 On November 2, 2023, the plaintiff wrote to the defendant explaining the loan also requesting that the plaintiff makes a payment of \$250.00 by November 20, 2023 (Exhibit 3).
- 6 On Friday November 3, 2023, the defendant wrote to the plaintiff stating that he would make a payment on November 26, 2023 (Exhibit 4).
- 7 As of Monday May 13, 2024, the defendant has not made any payment
- 8 As of Monday May 13, 2024, the Defendant has an outstanding balance of \$1,560.00 plus \$50.00 late fee for the first day late as per contract. and as per contract 50% to be added to the balance total \$2,415.00 and simple interest at 2.5% for \$74.76 from February 27, 2023, and thereafter \$0.17 per day.

AND the Plaintiff claims:

- (1) The sum of \$2,415.00.
- (2) Fixed costs of \$150.00, \$25.00 filing fee and process server fee \$125.00 alternatively costs to be assessed.
- (3) Interest at \$0.17 per day
