

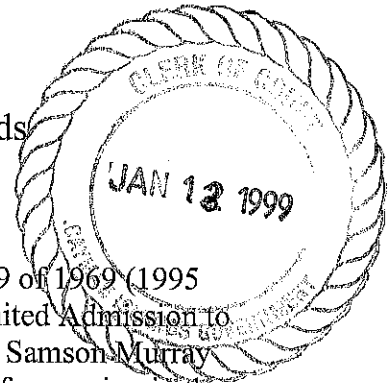




GREETINGS:

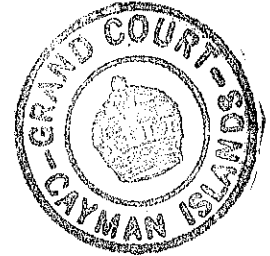
