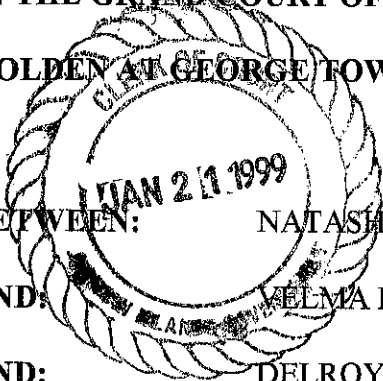

**THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS** has been issued against you by the abovenamed Plaintiff in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within (14 days) after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Courts Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

## STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff is a lawful child and one of the persons entitled to share in the estate of CRAWFORD DILBERT, late of George Town, Grand Cayman who died on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1998.
2. That the late CRAWFORD DILBERT died leaving in his possession a testamentary script.
3. That the aforesaid testamentary script (undated) was not duly executed in accordance with the provisions of the Wills Law (R.).

### AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

1. That the Court shall pronounce against the validity of the said Will (undated).
2. A Grant to the Plaintiff of Letters of Administration of the estate of the deceased.

This Writ is issued against you as the beneficiaries named in a document purporting to be the Last Will and Testament of the said deceased (undated).
