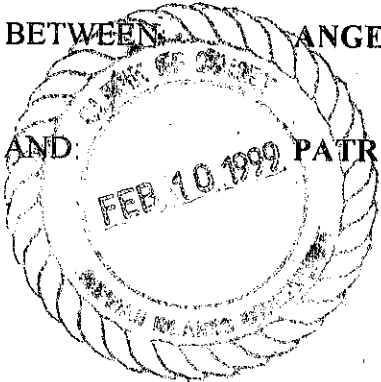

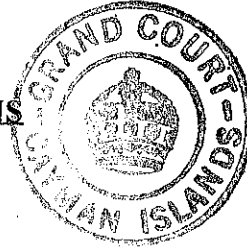

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

3. An order restraining the defendant from approaching within 100 yards of the Plaintiff's residence at 122 Hawkins Drive, Windsor Park.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

1. The Plaintiff and the Defendant were intimate friends and lived at 122 Hawkins Drive, Windsor Park, George Town.

2. On Sunday the 13th December, 1998 at about 4:00 p.m. the Plaintiff was at a friend's house on Ellery Merren Drive off Walkers Road in George Town when the Defendant, in a rage, rushed at the Plaintiff, grabbed her by her blouse, jerked her around several times and administered several blows to her head before she could be rescued by a friend.

3. Again, on the 11th January, 1999 at about 12:30 a.m. while the Plaintiff was asleep, the Defendant attacked the Plaintiff in such a violent, threatening and abusive manner that the Plaintiff, believing that her life was in danger, ran from her bed to seek refuge at her brother's home while the Defendant remains in the Plaintiff's house.

4. By reason of the matters aforesaid the Plaintiff has suffered shock, and injury, loss and damage.


