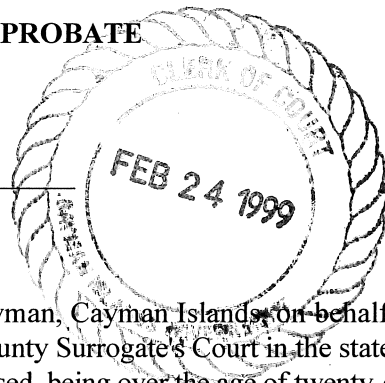

**APPLICATION FOR RESEALED GRANT OF PROBATE**

Succession Law, Section 23 (1)



We, W.S. Walker & Company of P. O. Box 265, George Town, Grand Cayman, Cayman Islands, on behalf of Bruce A. McKee and Fleet Bank, the Executors appointed by the Bergen County Surrogate's Court in the state of New Jersey of the estate of the late Alexander D. McKee, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which said Grant of Probate was made on the 11th day of January, 1989, and the said Grant of Probate, together with the Certificate of Death, is annexed hereto, HEREBY APPLY for a Resealed Grant of Probate of the estate of Alexander D. McKee and enclose the Affidavit of the Executors on that behalf and undertake that in the event of a Grant being made to the Executors:-

- (a) within six months of the Resealed Grant of Letters of Probate, we will prepare a true Inventory of the said estate in the Cayman Islands and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and
- (b) within one year of such Grant to the Executors we will arrange to have the assets comprising the said estate in the Cayman Islands administered according to the directions, if any, of the Court and arrange for the Executors to file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said Cayman Islands estate.
