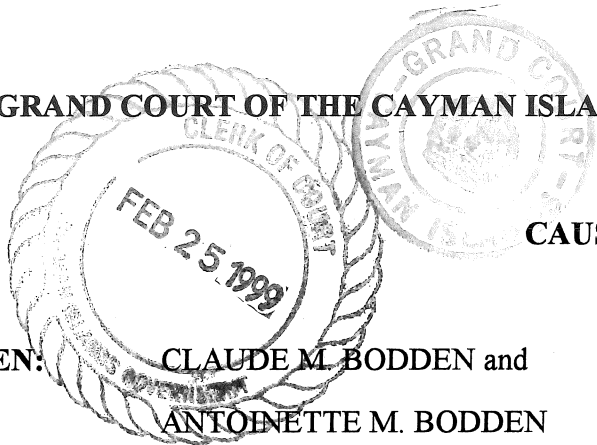

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the abovenamed Plaintiffs in respect of the claim set out on the next page.

Within (14 days) after the service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgment of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgment within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgment without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning the date of issue unless renewed by Order of the Court.


STATEMENT OF CLAIM


1. The Plaintiffs were at all material times the owners and lessors of a dwelling house located at George Town East, Block 20E, Parcel 60, Grand Cayman.
2. The Defendants were at all material times the lessees of the said premises from the Plaintiffs.
3. By written agreement, made on the 3rd day of April 1996, the Defendants leased the said premises at a monthly rental of CI \$1,000.00. By the terms of the said agreement, the lessees were responsible to maintain the said premises in a clean and reasonable condition. Notice was agreed to be one month or one month's in default of notice.
4. That the Defendants moved out on or about the 15th day of June, 1998 owing the sum of CI \$5,700.00 in respect to arrears of rent for the period October, 1997 through June, 1998, having failed to maintain the said premises in a reasonable condition causing the Plaintiffs to incur several costs for repairs and cleaning.
5. The Plaintiffs make the following claims:-
 - (a) Costs for materials and labour to restore the premises in a reasonable and tenable condition in the amount of CI \$2,890.00.
 - (b) Arrears of rental in the amount of CI \$5,700.00.
6. Despite oral and written requests made by the Plaintiffs to the Defendants the Defendants have refused and still refuse to pay the said outstanding amount of CI \$8,590.00.


AND the Plaintiff claims against the Defendants:

1. The sum of CI \$8,590.00
2. Costs and Attorney's fees.
3. Interest at the statutory rate.
4. Such further relief as this Honourable Court deems fit.

[If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgment of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed (including interest and costs) further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or his Attorney]
