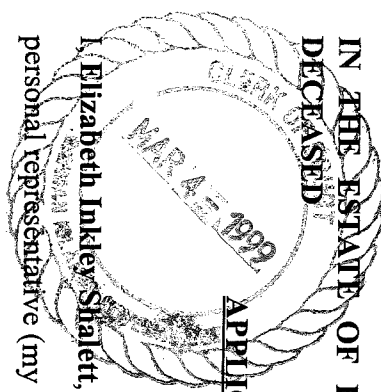

Inkley, of 45 Katherine Blvd., Palm Harbour, Florida, 33684, USA, surviving the deceased, being over the age of twenty one years and not having renounced probate, which said Will was made in the County of Pinellas in the State of Florida on the 8th day of July, 1997 and the said Will, at the time of the death of the deceased, having been placed in the firm safe of the law firm, Trenam, Kemker, Scharf, Barkin, Frye, O'Neill & Mullis, of 2700 Barnett Plaza, 101 East Kennedy Boulevard, P.O. Box 1102, Tampa, Florida, USA, 33601-1102 and subsequently deposited with the Pinellas County Circuit Court, certified copy of the said Will, together with the Certificate of Death, is annexed hereto, hereby apply for a Grant of Probate of the said Will to me and I enclose my Affidavit in that behalf and I understand that in the event of such grant being made to me:

- a) within six months of the grant to me of probate of the said Will I will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry, and
- b) within one year of such grant to me I will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the Will and directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
