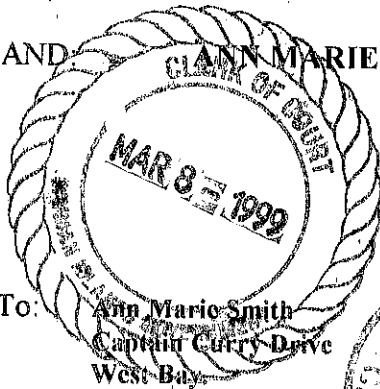

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 8th day of March, 1999.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

1. **The plaintiff claims** against the Defendant is for the sum of \$6,000.00 monies due and owing as a result of an agreement made on the 4th September, 1998 between the plaintiffs and the defendant whereby it was agreed that in consideration of the Defendant being responsible for any expense that may result therefrom, the plaintiff would stand as surety for Garfield M. Smith, the defendants, husband, plus costs and interest.
