ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET the Defendant, W.S. Walker & Co., a firm of attorneys practicing at Walker House, P.O. Box 265GT, George Town, Grand Cayman, attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, Grand Cayman, on the 23 day of April, 1999 at 9:30 o'clock a.m. on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff, PriceWaterhouseCoopers, a firm of accountants practicing at British American Centre, P.O. Box 258GT, George Town, Grand Cayman for the following orders:

1. An injunction restraining the Defendant from acting on behalf of Banco Economico SA and its liquidators in connection with (a) a summons issued on 26th November, 1998 in the matter of Transworld Bank & Trust Limited (In Liquidation), Cause No. 281 of 1997 by which Banco Economico SA is seeking and/or supporting an application that two partners of the Plaintiff firm be removed from office as liquidators of the said Transworld Bank & Trust Limited and (2) an action, Cause No. 344 of 1996, pending between Transworld Bank & Trust Limited (In Liquidation) as plaintiff and Banco Economico SA as defendant.

2. Further or other relief.

3. Costs.

AND LET the Defendant within 14 days after service of this Summons on them counting the day of service return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office.

**DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE
OF ORIGINATING SUMMONS**

The accompanying form of Acknowledgement of Service should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person. After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P. O. Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman.

Notes for Guidance

1. Each Defendant (if there are more than one) is required to complete an Acknowledgement of Service and return it to the Courts Office.
2. If you wish to defend claims made in the originating summons, or intend to attend the proceedings and to participate in them so far as necessary (although not necessarily in an adversarial manner) you should tick the "Yes" box in paragraph 2 of the Acknowledgement of service.
3. For the purpose of calculating the period of 14 days for acknowledging service, a writ served on the Defendant personally is treated as having been served on the day it was delivered to him.
4. Where the Defendant is sued in a name different from his own, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the words "sued as (the name stated on the Originating Summons)".
5. Where the Defendant is a FIRM and an attorney is not instructed, the form must be completed by a PARTNER by name, with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "Partner in the firm of (.....)" after his name.
6. Where the Defendant is sued as an individual TRADING IN A NAME OTHER THAN HIS OWN, the form must be completed by him with the addition in paragraph 1 of the description "trading as (.....)" after his name.
7. Where the Defendant is a LIMITED COMPANY the form must be completed by an Attorney or by someone authorised to act on behalf of the Company, but the Company can take no further step in the proceedings without an Attorney acting on its behalf.

8. Where the Defendant is a MINOR or a MENTAL PATIENT, the form must be completed by an Attorney acting for a guardian ad litem.

9. A Defendant acting in person may obtain help in completing the form at the Courts Office.

In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered principal office.
