

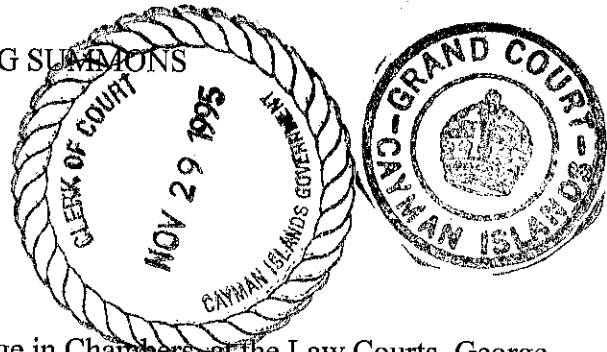

4. That the Plaintiff be awarded the costs of this application.

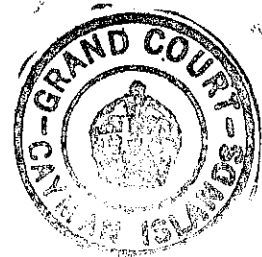

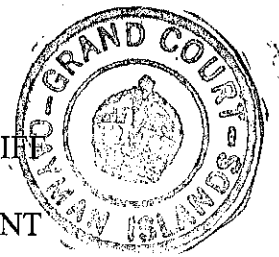
