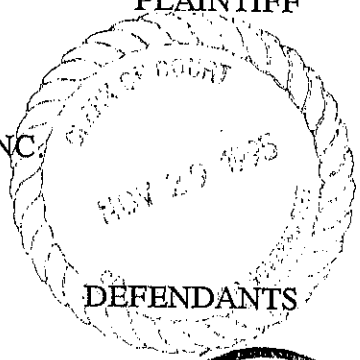

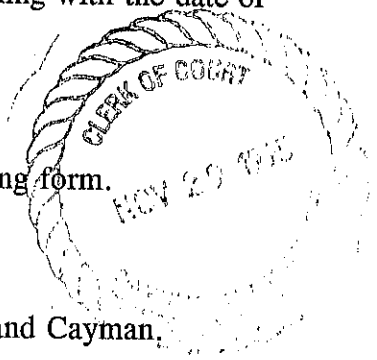

STATEMENT OF CLAIM

- (1) The Plaintiff is a firm of attorneys practising in George Town, Grand Cayman.
- (2) In July 1994 the Plaintiff was engaged by the 1st Defendant to act on behalf of himself and the 2nd to 6th Defendant companies in connection with an action (Cause No. 499 of 1994) then pending in the Grand Court. The 1st Defendant agreed on behalf of himself and his companies to pay a reasonable professional fee for work reasonably and properly done.
- (3) The Plaintiff's fees for acting on behalf of the 1st Defendant and his companies was US\$36,701.60.

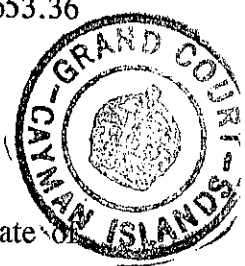

- (4) The Defendants are jointly and severally indebted to the Plaintiff in the sum of US\$21,701.63.
- (5) The Plaintiff claims interest pursuant to Section 34(1) of the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) calculated at the prescribed rate from the 1st December, 1994 as follows:

US\$21,701.63 @ 8-3/8% from 1st December, 1994 to date -	
US\$4.98 per day for 332 days	US\$ 1,653.36

AND THE PLAINTIFF claims:

- 2. Interest pursuant to statute in the sum of US\$1,65.36 and continuing at the rate of US\$4.98 per day;

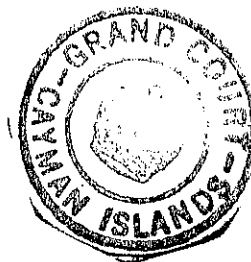
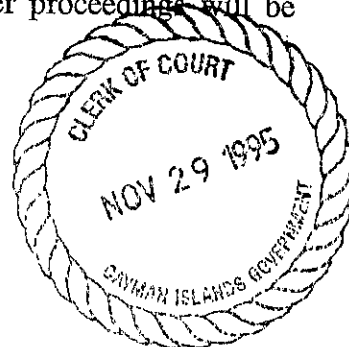


3. Fixed costs of CI\$600 (including the filing fee).
