

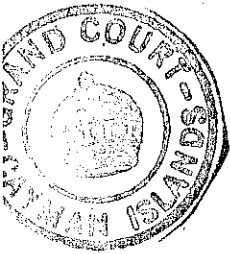
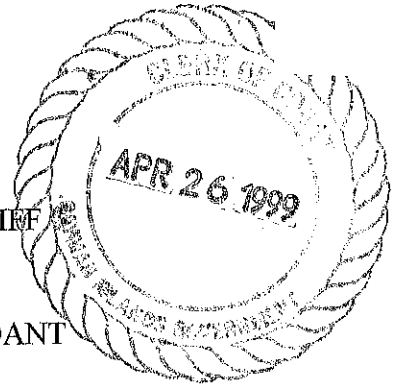

THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

Within fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 26 day of April, 1999.

NOTE - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

SPECIAL INDORSEMENT

1. The plaintiff is an Attorney-at-Law.
2. About May, 1995 to October, 1997 the plaintiff did legal work for the defendant valued at \$33,708.93 which the defendant promised to pay when he sold certain apartments which he had under construction but he sold the said apartments and failed to pay the plaintiff.
3. By letter dated the 26th June, 1998 the plaintiff demanded payment of his legal fees plus interest making a total of \$37,864.76 within twenty one days.
4. By letter dated the 22nd July, 1998 the defendant acknowledged that he owed the plaintiff \$26,614.76 but has failed to make any payments towards the said debt.

Wherefore the plaintiff claims:-
