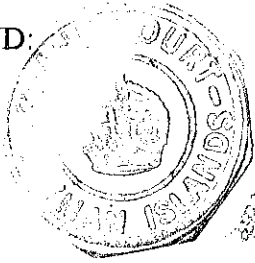

**WRIT OF SUMMONS**

**THIS WRIT OF SUMMONS** has been issued against you by the above-named Plaintiff in respect of a claim set out the next page.

**Within** fourteen (14) days after service of this Writ on you, counting the day of service, you must either satisfy the claim or return to the Court Office, P.O.Box 495G, George Town, Grand Cayman, the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service stating therein whether you intend to contest these proceedings.

If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

Issued the 7th day of December, 1995.

**NOTE** - This Writ may not be served later than 4 calendar months (or, if leave is required to effect service out of the jurisdiction, 6 months) beginning with the date of issue unless renewed by order of the Court.

**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**

1. On the 14th day of February, 1995 the plaintiff was driving her 1986 Crysler Station Waggon (a taxi) along the West bay Road, when, on reaching the vicinity of Indies Suites, the defendant's Cadillac Seville Motor Car, Registration Number 46751, collided with the plaintiff's taxi .
2. The the said collision was caused by the negligence of the defendant.

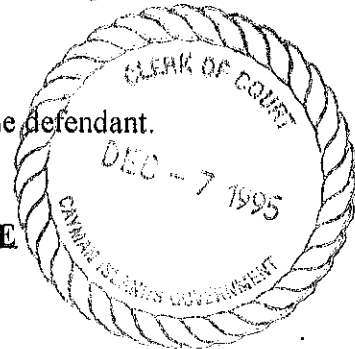
**PARTICULARS OF NEGLIGENCE**

1. Driving at excessive speed;
2. Trying to overtake in the face of on-coming car.
3. Trying to overtake when it was unsafe to do so.
4. Failing to apply his breaks in time or at all or to steer or control his motor car so as to avoid the said collision.

**By reason of the matters aforesaid, the plaintiff suffered personal injuries and pain and loss and damage.**

**PARTICULARS OF INJURIES**

1. The plaintiff, after the accident suffered pain and tenderness in the muscles of the back of the neck and pain and tenderness in the muscles alongside the thoracic spine.



2. There was limitation of rotation of her head towards the right side due to pain, and limitation of flexion to the left of her body.
3. X-ray revealed a loss of the normal curvature of the spine.
4. The plaintiff was diagnosed to have suffered a whip lash.
5. The plaintiff will rely upon the medical evidence to detail the full extent of her injuries.
