If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgement may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

The Plaintiff's claim is for damages for loss sustained in a road traffic accident which occurred on the 12<sup>th</sup> June 1996 on West Bay Road, Grand Cayman caused by the negligent driving of the Defendant.
