If you fail to satisfy the claim or to return the Acknowledgement within the time stated, or if you return the Acknowledgement without stating therein an intention to contest the proceedings, the Plaintiff may proceed with the action and judgment may be entered against you forthwith without further notice.

ENDORSEMENT

The Plaintiff claims against the Defendant:-

1. The Plaintiff's claim is for US\$310,000.00 for a loss under a policy of insurance no. IMA832824A with an effective policy period from 10th January 1998 to 10th January 1999 upon the yacht "Juju".
2. Alternatively, damages.
3. Pre-judgement interest in accordance with the Judicature Law (1995 Revision) from 23rd May 1998 until the date hereof in the sum of US\$21,461.45 and continuing thereafter at the rate of US\$59.45 per day until payment.
4. Further or other relief as the Court deems just.
5. Costs.

If, within the time for returning the Acknowledgement of Service, the Defendant pays the total amount claimed of US\$331,461.45 together with the sum of US\$750.00 in respect of costs and fees, further proceedings will be stayed. The money must be paid to the Plaintiff or its attorneys.
