





**STATEMENT OF CLAIM**

1. The Plaintiff was an employee of the Defendant's company during the period 1991 to 1996.
2. The Plaintiff's claim is against the Defendant for the sum of CIS 27,238.16 being the outstanding principal for services rendered to the Defendant during the period July 1992 through to March 1996 in respect of her work with Ralston Publications Ltd. subsequently Galco Media Ltd.
3. An Employment Agreement was signed by the Plaintiff with the Defendant on July 1995 to take effect from the 16th July 1992 for payment in the amount of CIS\$2,700.00 per month.
4. The Plaintiff terminated employment effective the 28<sup>th</sup> February 1996, although she in fact finally left the Defendant's employment in March 1996.
5. The Plaintiff carried out the duties as set out in the Employment Agreement in the Production and Distribution of an in-flight magazine "Destination Cayman" amongst other duties for Ralston Publications Ltd.
6. The Plaintiff is still outstanding CIS\$27,238.16 and has made several demands for payment from the Defendant.
7. The Plaintiff is entitled to full recovery of her outstanding salary and legal costs incurred in enforcing the agreement.

**AND THE PLAINTIFF CLAIMS: -**

1. AN ORDER for the payment by the Defendant of the sum of CIS\$27,238.16
2. Interest at the statutory rate following judgement.
3. FURTHER and/or other relief.
4. COSTS.

DIRECTIONS FOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE OF WRIT OF  
SUMMONS

1. The accompanying form of *Acknowledgement of Service* should be completed by an Attorney acting on behalf of the Defendant or by the Defendant if acting in person.

After completion it must be delivered or sent by post to the Law Courts, P.O. Box 495GT, George Town, Grand Cayman.

2. A Defendant who states in his Acknowledgement of Service that he intends to contest the proceedings *must also serve a defense* on the Attorney for the Plaintiff (or on the Plaintiff if acting in person).

If a Statement of Claim is indorsed on the Writ (i.e. the words "Statement of Claim" appear on the top of the page 2), the Defense must be served within 14 days after the time for acknowledgement service of the Writ, unless in the meantime a summons for judgement is served on the Defendant.

If the Statement of Claim is not indorsed on the Writ, the Defense need not be served until 14 days after a Statement of Claim has been served on the Defendant.

If the Defendant fails to serve his defense within the appropriate time, the Plaintiff may enter judgement against him without further notice.

3. A *Stay of Execution* against the Defendant's goods may be applied for where the Defendant is unable to pay the money for which any judgement is entered. If a Defendant to an action for a debt or liquidated demand (i.e. a fixed sum) who does not intend to contest the proceedings states, in answer to Question 3 in the Acknowledgement of Service, that he intends to apply for a stay, execution will be stayed 14 days after his Acknowledgement, but he must, within that time, *issue a Summons* for a stay of execution, supported by an affidavit of his means.

***Notes on address for service***

**Attorney:** where the Defendant is represented by an attorney, state the attorney's place of business in the Cayman Islands. A Defendant may not act by a foreign attorney.

**Defendant in person:** where the Defendant is acting in person, he must give his post office box number and the physical address of his residence or, if he does not reside in the Cayman Islands, he must give an address in Grand Cayman where communications for him should be sent. In the case of a limited company, "residence" means its registered or principal office.

**Indorsement by plaintiff (or by plaintiff if suing in person)** of his name, address and reference, if any, in the box below.

**Indorsement by defendant's Attorney (or by defendant if suing in person)** of his name, address and reference, if any, in the box below.
