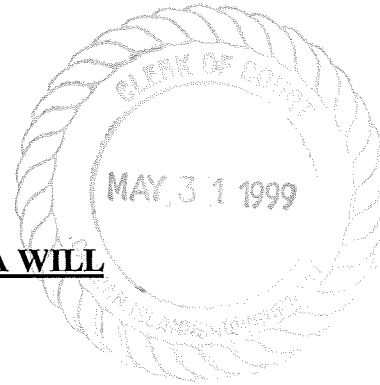

APPLICATION FOR A GRANT OF PROBATE OF A WILL
(Succession Law Section 3 (7))

I, **DAVID RITCH** of George Town, Grand Cayman being the Executor named in the last Will of the late **JANE ADAMS DUNHAM** of West Bay, Grand Cayman surviving the Deceased, being over the age of twenty-one years and not having renounced Probate, which said Will at the time of the death of the Deceased, was lodged in safekeeping at the offices of Ritch & Conolly, George Town, Grand Cayman, which said Will, together with the Certificate of Death, is annexed hereto, **HEREBY** apply for a grant of Probate of the said Will to me and I enclose my affidavit in that behalf and I undertake that in the event of such grant being made to me

- (a) within six months of the grant to me of Probate of the said Will I will prepare a true inventory of the said estate and exhibit and file the same in the Probate Registry; and

- (b) within one year of such grant to me I will administer the said estate according to the tenor of the Will and directions, if any, of the Court and file in the Probate Registry a general accounting for the whole of the assets of the said estate.
