

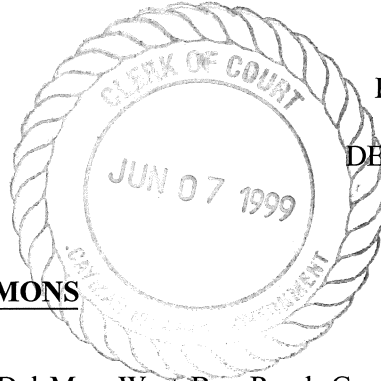
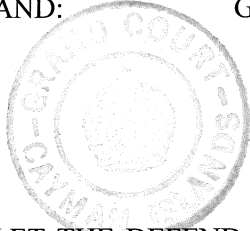

ORIGINATING SUMMONS

LET THE DEFENDANT of P.O. Box 30060, #16 Laguna Del Mar, West Bay Road, Grand Cayman, attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of July 1999 at 9.30 o'clock on the hearing of an application by the Plaintiff of 15010 Carmignano Di Brenta, Padova, Italy for orders that:-

1. The Defendant do immediately discontinue the proceedings brought by him against the Plaintiff herein in the Court of Treviso, Italy on 17<sup>th</sup> May 1999.
2. In the alternative the Defendant be restrained from continuing or prosecuting or assisting in the prosecution of the said proceedings commenced by the Defendant in Treviso, Italy.
3. The Defendant be restrained from commencing any further or other proceedings in Italy or elsewhere against the Plaintiff arising out of the dispute between the parties as to the beneficial ownership of Elbo Ltd., the alleged lending of any funds by the Defendant to the Plaintiff in relation to the purchase of villa no. 15 at the Caribbean Club, the beneficial ownership of any assets belonging to Elbo Ltd. including in particular villa no. 15 at the Caribbean Club or otherwise arising out of the relationship between the parties in the Cayman Islands except in pursuance of or to enforce an award made in Cause No. 252 of 1996.
4. The costs of this originating summons be the Plaintiff's.

AND LET THE DEFENDANT within fourteen days after service of this summons on him counting the day of service, return the accompanying Acknowledgement of Service to the Court's office.
