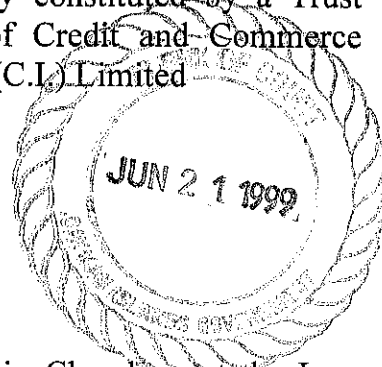

Ex Parte ORIGINATING SUMMONS



LET ALL PARTIES CONCERNED attend before the Judge in Chambers at the Law Courts, George Town, Grand Cayman on the 6 day of AUGUST 1999 at 9:30 o'clock on the hearing of this Summons by which the Plaintiff, Hexagon Trust Company (C.I.) Limited, the trustee of the Hexagon Welfare Trust, seeks the following relief pursuant to Order 85, Rule 2 (3) (c) of the Grand Court Rules, namely:

1. For directions whether the Plaintiff should or should not defend an action which has been commenced against it in the Grand Court the short title and reference to the record whereof are "Grand Court Cause No. 316 of 1999, Mohammad Ali Qayyum v. Hexagon Trust Company (C.I.) Limited (as trustee of the Hexagon Welfare Trust)", in relation to the funds the subject matter of the trust for the following relief, namely: an order that the trustee of the Hexagon Welfare Trust pay the Plaintiff, Raihan Nasir Mahmud, Qaiser Mansoor Malik, Mohammad Alam, Mashiur (sic) Rahman, Mian Abdul Saleem, Halida Shafiullah, Ronald James Rees and Ajmal Ebrahim Hameed their reasonable expenses, including professional fees and expenses and expenses of living and traveling abroad and such sums as are commensurate with their work and services carried out in connection with various proceedings in the High Court of Justice in England concerning the BCCI and ICIC Staff Benefit Trusts; in District Court and Court of Appeal

in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg relating to the approval of agreements between the Liquidators of BCCI and the Government of Abu Dhabi; and in the Grand Court and in the High Court of Justice in London, relating to the approval of the settlement of US\$70 million and the establishment of the Hexagon Welfare Trust and the Triangle Loans Trust.

2. That all further and necessary directions may be given.
3. That provision may be made for the costs of this application.
4. Further or other relief.
