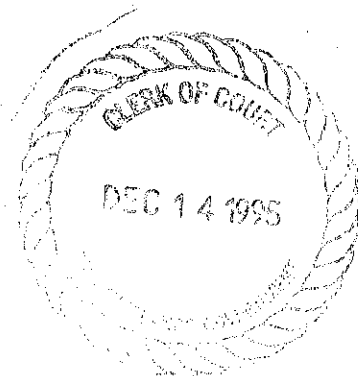
Grand Court in the Matrimonial Case Number D15/94, Edward Earl Johns vs. France
